This doesn't mean that we're all able to give large amounts of money. It means that no matter how much we can give, it is the gesture itself that is important. It means that we know generosity when we feel it. And generosity feels good!

During worship, we collect an Offering from our congregation. Joyfully, we give the overwhelming majority (80%) of our collection to worthy organizations - suggested by our members and friends - with whom we share core values. The remaining 20% helps to fund our congregational efforts for justice.

Potential Offering recipients should meet the following criteria:

- 1. Recipients' mission/values must reflect the core values of UUSGS.
- 2. Recipients must have a connection with UUSGS through shared work or congregational support.
- 3. Recipients will demonstrate a need for funding at the level we can provide.
- 4. The bulk of the recipient's budget goes to meeting the mission of the organization (i.e., not overhead costs).
